Sales Office for Advanced Weapon System Established in Robbins

Just two years ago, Robbins welcomed American Growler, Inc., manufacturer of specially-designed military vehicles, as the first defense-related industry to locate in northern Moore County. Today, Robbins is embracing another defense-related niche business that will be operated by a local couple. Joey and Martha Boswell have recently become the U.S. sales representatives for CornerShot™, an advanced anti-terrorism weapon system created and manufactured by Golan Group Global Security Solutions. The Boswells have based their sales office in Robbins where they will market and sell CornerShot™.

CornerShot™ is a revolutionary weapon system that enables military forces or law enforcement officials to observe and engage a target from around a corner without exposing any body parts. The system attaches to most top-tier semi-automatic and select-fire pistols and then swivels left or right, depending on the direction of the corner. Sold only to official government organizations, law enforcement agencies and authorized distributors, it is already being used by Special Forces, military units and law enforcement groups around the world.

Golan Group, an international company based in Boca Raton, Florida is the corporate headquarters for CornerShot in the US. CornerShot™ was founded by Amos Golan, an Israeli Anti-Terror Unit Commander in the Israel Defense Forces. Golan, one of the developers of CornerShot™, commented, "Today's combat situations, such as fighting in urban terrain and inside inhabited buildings, unnecessarily expose security forces to the enemy and present an immediate risk to their lives. CornerShot™ removes the need for this initial exposure."

The Robbins sales office is the only other U.S. office, in addition to the headquarters in Boca Raton, authorized to sell the complete CornerShot™ line of weapon systems and accessories. The company also maintains offices in various overseas locations, including Israel, El Salvador and Honduras. "CornerShot™ maintains highly-skilled engineers, technicians and weapons specialists for R&D and production at its office in Israel. Each product is created with state-of-the-art technology and fully complies with the ISO-9001:2000 quality assurance standard," said Martha Boswell.

Both Joey and Martha Boswell will be certified by Golan Group to be CornerShot™ trainers, and they hope to eventually offer customer training in Robbins and at customer locations.

Ray Ogden, Executive Director of Moore County Partners in Progress, the economic development organization serving all of Moore County, commented, “The Boswells’ endeavor to establish the CornerShot™ sales office in Robbins supports our economic development efforts to recruit defense contractors and military-support companies to Moore County.”

“The presence of American Growler and now CornerShot™ here helps make Moore County more attractive to other defense companies looking for a location close to Fort Bragg,” Ogden explained.
